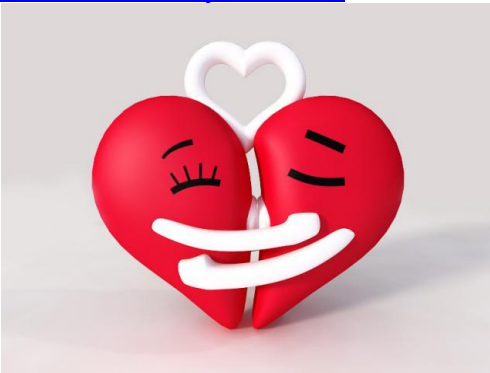
We held the first BT cabin fever event here a few years ago. It has taken this long for the owners to forget about that event.

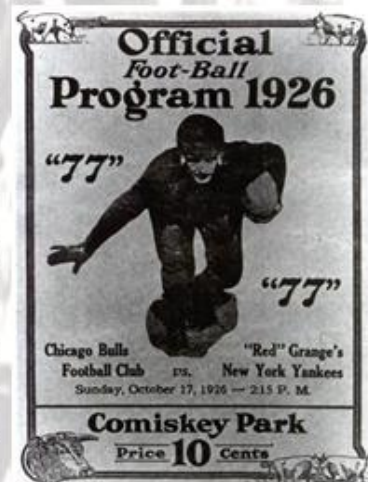

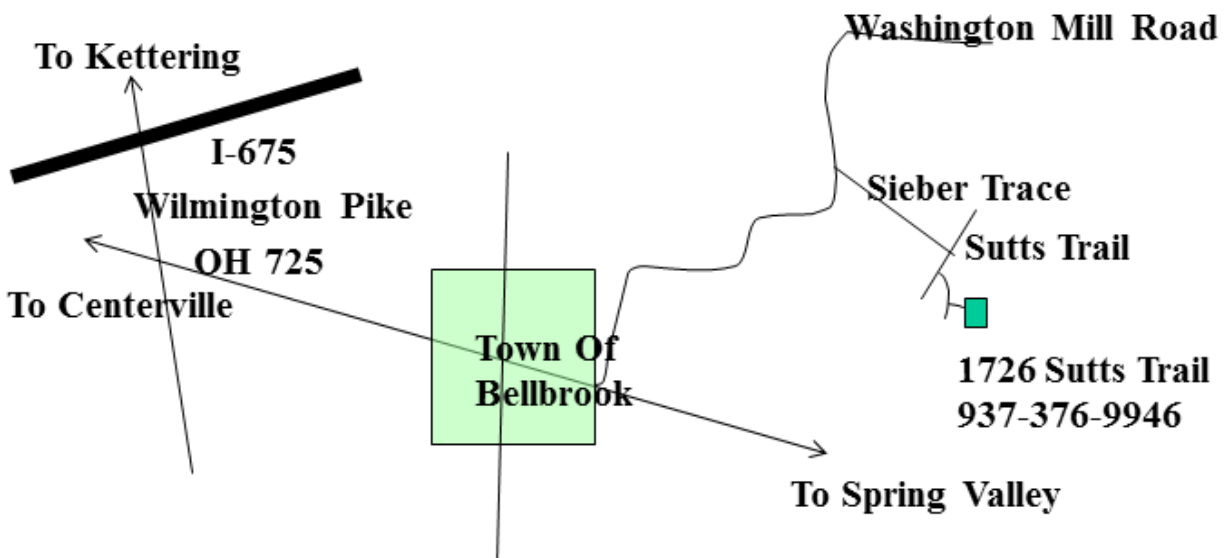

Directions From Kettering: Take Wilmington Pike to OH 725 (Alex Bell Rd) Turn left and follow through the lovely town of Bellbrook. As you leave the town's east side there will be a road on the right, Washington Mill (hard to miss - there is a driving range on the corner and it's across from a closed ice cream shop/stand - it's also the second left after the light in "downtown" Bellbrook. Turn left on Washington Mill and follow it until it comes up out of the valley and makes a sharp left turn. Right after this turn is a road to the right called Sieber Trace. Turn on Sieber Trace and follow it until it dead-ends. That's Sutts Trail. Turn right on Sutts and turn down the asphalt driveway on your left which is flanked by two stone mailboxes (only one, "1726" is beside the first one). Go through the woods and cross the creek and we're the first house you come to, a contemporary ranch sitting up a bit with the four car garage. Park as close to the garage as you can - if you see the Subarus sitting on the lawn don't park next to them! Lost? Call 937-376-9946 or 937-238-4962 – see you there!

Year End Analysis

The Club started on January 1, 2015 with \$3450.84 in the treasury. 2015 was an average year for expenses. Largest increase in income was the British Car Day Car Show. This year's BCD was well above the average. The Club netted \$2400.00 in 2015 versus \$1800.00 in 2014. The club ended the year with \$4499.40.
